The climate will still collapse. The world has moved from climate change as a future emergency to climate collapse. It's time for you to be decisive. For our national security, our economic security, our human security and our environmental security.

I look forward to hearing from you PM Albo. I know you love your mum. I love my mum too. She's 83 and is behind me 110% on this. Like you, I grew up doing it tough. I remember living in a caravan and sleeping on mattresses on the floor. But my mum, like yours was a brave, strong and caring single mum to me.

On Monday when you come back to Parliament House I will be waiting for you in my swag on the lawns out front.
